

Public Hearing
Susquehanna Heritage Area Management Update
July 8, 2010

The Public Hearing on public review and comment regarding the final draft plan for the Susquehanna Heritage Area Management update and its associated SEQR review was called to order by the Chair at 1:00 P.M. All Legislative members were present.

There were 9 people in attendance.

The Clerk read the legal notice as published in the official newspapers.

George Penney spoke. "I wish to say there is no need for Tioga County to take a second place to Broome County in anything. First off, Tioga County is the home of Todd Loring, who traveled with Teddy Roosevelt to the Pacific. Tioga County is the home of Belva Lockwood, the first woman candidate for President. Tioga County is the home of Washington Gladden Composer of sacred hymns. Tioga County was the home of General Robert, Robert's Rules of Orders with which we are all familiar. Tioga County was the home of John D. Rockefeller, one of the world's richest men.

"Tioga County is the site of the Nation's earliest railroads. Tioga County has six existing railroad depots. Tioga County has three active museums and two inactive museums. I repeat, there is no need for Tioga County to take second place to Broome County in anything. Thank you."
