TIOGA COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE – APRIL 25, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **90 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **80 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine.** These are individuals who have had close contact (6 ft.) with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals that have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19.
- **1 Individuals in Precautionary Quarantine.** These are individuals who have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy while COVID-19 was prevalent, but is not displaying symptoms; or is known to have had a proximate exposure to a positive person but has not had direct contact with a positive person and is not displaying symptoms.
- **2 Pending Tests**
- **22 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom and fever-free that meet the criteria to be released from Isolation.
- **6 Deaths**

A statement from Chairwoman Sauerbrey. “Please be aware that this is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time. Administered tests are tracked in various ways.”

“The total lives lost to date is six individuals who were residents of Elderwood Nursing Home in Waverly, NY. Elderwood is continuing testing for all residents and staff members. I ask for your prayers and positive thoughts for all those concerned.”
