1.0 REQUIRED SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.0 Scheduling

It is anticipated that contracts for the required monitoring services will be awarded on or about **Wednesday**, **August 17**, **2022** to the lowest responsible bidder.

Monitoring firms must be available to provide services on start dates as determined and coordinate their schedules with the Demolition Contractor to be awarded.

REQUIRED SCOPE OF SERVICES

3.0 Asbestos Project Construction Administration

Contractor shall provide additional support to TCPDC's by an Asbestos Designer and his project asbestos abatement design experience. Support will include contractor submittal reviews and project coordination for one (1) general contractor asbestos demolition contractor (i.e. review bid documents, addendums, submittals, run and attend pre-construction meeting and requests for information).

Contractor shall provide the additional services including project coordination support and bid document support during pre-construction meetings and actual project demolition.

Contractor will review up to four (4) sets of pre-construction submittals and four (4) sets of closeout submittals. This shall be limited to the review of eight (8) submissions of all submittals required by contract documents for one (1) abatement contractor. Additional submittal review for additional abatement contractors shall be considered additional work. Submittal reviews shall be forwarded to the owner and contractor for product record.

Contractor shall provide up to three (3) hours of project administration per week (based on eight (8) week schedule) during the asbestos abatement demolition phase of the project to address any possible requests for information or other contractor concerns including review of construction contract scope of work.

Contractor shall attend one (1) pre-construction project meeting and will prepare a preconstruction meeting agenda, prepare meeting notes and transmit to all parties.

3.1 Post Abatement Demolition Site Inspections:

Contractor will perform the TCPDC's post abatement demolition site inspections for the project. The structure will require three (3) inspections of the contractor's site restoration work (empty foundation; (clean per requirements); after topsoil (before seed and mulch – check top soil and grade per documents and final completion (after soil, mulch and punch list items). Daily site reports and photographs will be created for the project record.

Contractor will begin the project work within 48 hours from Notice to Proceed.

4.0 Other Requirements

4.1 Insurance

No Contractor shall commence work under this contract until he has obtained all the insurance required hereinafter issued by a company duly authorized to do business in the State of New York. The Contractor shall not allow any subcontractor to commence work on his subcontract until all similar insurance required of the subcontractor has been obtained and approved. Approval of the insurance by the Owner shall not relieve or decrease the liability of each contractor. CLAIMS MADE INSURANCE SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE.

A. Worker's Compensation and other Mandated Insurance Each Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of this contract, the statutory Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance, and all other insurance required by law, for all of his employees engaged in work under this contract, and in case any such work in sublet, the contractor shall require the

subcontractor to provide all similar insurance.

Each Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract a Comprehensive General Liability Insurance policy for Bodily Injury, including accidental death, and Property Damage, as shall protect him and any subcontractor performing work covered by this contract from claims for damages which may arise from operations under this contract, whether such operations be by himself, or by any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them. TCPDC should be named as an additional insured. General aggregate liability shall be \$2,000,000. The hazards insured against shall be as checked below:

- Premises-Operations
- Products/Completed Operations

- Contractual Insurance
- Broad Form Property Damage
- Independent Contractors

4.2 Experience and Qualifications

Bidders must be skilled and regularly engaged in the class of work bid, and, if required by TCPDC, must submit satisfactory evidence of mechanical facilities and financial ability to do the work with the agreed time and in accordance with all the requirements of the Contract. The successful bidder will be required to keep the entire work of the Contract at all times under his control. This bid and proposal are not assignable or conveyable in any fashion and may not be pledged or encumbered without the express written permission of TCPDC other requirements for bidding are included elsewhere in these Specifications.

4.3 Selection

TCPDC expressly reserves the right at any time herein, to change the requirements or specifications of this bid and the demolition, requested thereunder. TCPDC further reserves the right to reject all bids hereunder and re-bid the job or, at its sole discretion, to not award the job to any bidder following receipt of any and all bids hereunder. TCPDC shall not be bound to award the demolitions herein, regardless of bids received

5.0 Payment

The Contractor will be paid upon completion for the total value of the contract within 15 working days of completion.

5.0 Proposal Submission

Quotations shall include a detailed description of the scope of services to be provided. Pricing for each property shall include the estimated number of regular and overtime (if applicable) hours, quantities of air samples to be analyzed including analytical turnaround times, and a daily rate for expenses. The daily rate for expenses shall include all equipment and materials necessary to perform the required scope of services (e.g., mileage, sampling pumps, sampling cassettes, power cords, portable generators, personal protective equipment, sample shipping, etc.). Unit rates for all categories (labor, analysis and expenses), and a total estimated project cost, shall be provided. All **Bidders to submit with this proposal: Company license and Project Designer Certification. Bidders must also complete and sign the attached Non-Collusive Bidding Certification.**

Any proposals received later than the submission deadline <u>will not be accepted or</u> <u>considered.</u> The TCPDC will not be responsible for late submission caused by the postal service, other carriers, or any other delivery problems regardless of the reason.
